Sir,

This has reference to your letter No. Nil dated 25.05.2015 seeking extension of validity of Environment Clearance and change of title of Environment Clearance in the name of M/s Puspit Steels Private Limited for the project mentioned above.

2. The project was accorded Environmental Clearance by the Ministry *vide* letter F.No. J-11011/137/2008-IA II (I) dated 28<sup>th</sup> May 2008 in the name of M/s. Sri Venkateswara Sponge & Power Private Limited. Since the Company M/s. Sri Venkateswara Sponge & Power Private Limited has incurred losses continuously and became a sick unit and it was taken over by Andhra Bank. The Andhra Bank subsequently auctioned the Company and was taken over by M/s. Puspit Steels Private Limited through auction on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2013.

3. M/s. Puspit Steels Private Limited after taking over the Company applied for extension of validity of environmental clearance for a period of 3 years and transfer of environmental clearance from M/s. Sri Venkateswara Sponge & Power Private Limited to M/s. Puspit Steels Private Limited.


4. The proposal was placed before the Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry-I) during its 43<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2015. The Committee recommended the proposal of extension of validity of environmental clearance for further period of 3 years i.e. upto 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2018.

5. The Ministry has considered the recommendation of the EAC (Industry-I) and hereby decided to extend the validity of the Environmental Clearance issued *vide* letter No. J-11011/137/2008-IA II (I) dated 28<sup>th</sup> May 2008 upto 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2018.
